2022 RECORD: (30-7 at Centennial Field, 17-13 on road)

* The Lake Monsters begin their 3rd Futures League season tonight after having won both the 2021 and 2022 FCBL regular-season titles with a combined **86-43** record (**42-24** in 2021 and **42-23** in 2022)

* Since July 1, 2021 Vermont has **81-28** record in regular-season/playoffs

* While Vermont is in 3rd FCBL year, it's the 29th season overall for the Lake Monsters who were Minor League short-season NY-Penn League affiliate 1994-2019 with Montreal, Washington and Oakland

* **990-1092** all-time regular-season (**904-1050** NYPL, **86-43** FCBL)

LIDLIFTERS: Vermont is 0-2 in first 2 Futures League openers having lost 3-2 in 10-innings at Westfield in 2021 and in HR Derby last season

* Overall, **Vermont is 9-19 all-time in 28 season openers all-time**

* Lake Monsters 1-1 in FCBL home openers (10-7 loss 2021, 6-3 win 2022)

LOOKING BACK: After starting 2022 season with 3 straight losses, Vermont had a 13-game winning streak and won 23 of 25 for 23-5 record

* Lake Monsters went 21-14 over their final 35 regular-season games to finish with **FCBL record 44 wins** (44-19) after record 42 wins in 2021

* After a 2-game sweep of Westfield in the semifinals and a 12-0 win over Nashua in game 1 of finals, Vermont lost 6-5 in both game 2 and 3

MOST & FEW IN '22: Vermont's **399 runs** were most in FCBL by 40 (Westfield 359), **266 runs allowed** fewest by 40 (New Britain 306)

* Lake Monsters lead FCBL with 31 homers (Pittsfield 2nd w/30 HR)

STRIKING STAFF IN '22: Vermont pitchers lead the FCBL with **613 strikeouts**, 97 more strikeouts than 2nd-place Nashua Silver Knights (516)

* Lake Monster pitchers 10+ strikeouts 36 of 63 games (opponents 18)

TV IN '23: Along with all 64 Lake Monster home and road games streaming live (and on demand) at fcblnetwork.com for 3rd straight year, **8 home games (plus All-Star Game) will be simulcast live on WYCI-TV**

* Dates for all 9 TV games can be found at schedule to the left

RETURNEES: As of opening day, 10 players are scheduled to return to the Lake Monsters for either their 2nd or 3rd season in Vermont

* To start season **Colby Brouillette, Wyatt Cameron, Francis Ferguson** and **Silas Reed** return for 3rd seasons (**Tyler Favretto** expected in early June)

* Back for a 2nd season are **Tommy Martin, Oliver Pudvar** and **Tanner Wolpert** with **William Gumbrell** and **Logan Keller** are expected soon

LOCAL TIES: With 6 players on the opening day roster and 5 more scheduled to join team over next month, 11 players from the state of Vermont signed to play for Monsters this summer (see list above right)

STARS AT CENTENNIAL: The Vermont Lake Monsters will be hosting the **2023 Futures League All-Star Game at historic Centennial Field on Tuesday, July 25th** with first pitch scheduled for 6:35 pm

* Centennial Field with also host the **2023 FCBL Home Run Derby** (and post-derby concert) Monday, July 24th also scheduled for 6:35 pm

Tommy Hawke (Wake Forest) is hitting .355 (77x217) with 63 r, 16 2b, 5 hr, 27 rbi, 44 bb, 42 so before ACC Tourney

Sean Matson (Harvard) was 3-5 with 5.02 era (61 ip, 69 h, 41 r, 34 er, 20 bb, 59 so) in 13 games (11 starts)

Patrick Harrington (Northeastern) was 5-0 with 2 saves, 3.79 ERA (38 IP, 33 H, 19 R, 16 ER, 17 BB, 29 SO) 18 games
