LAST NIGHT: Lake Monsters 12-12-2, Worcester 2-6-3

* Vermont 6 runs on 6 straight hits to open bottom 8th inning for a 12-2 advantage and the walkoff victory with 10-run mercy rule
 * **Tom Vesosky** was 2-for-4 with 2 runs and a 2-run triple/scored on throwing error to 3rd base to clinch the 10-run Vermont win
 * **Noah Granet** 3-for-4 with 1 run and 2 doubles, **M.J. Metz** 2-for-3 with RBI single and double, while **Darren Hagan** leadoff HR in 1st
 * Vermont broke 2-2 tie with 3 runs in the 6th and another in the 7th
 * Starter **Brett Hansen** 2 runs, 0 walks and 5 strikeouts in 4 IP, while **Chris Clark** retired 12 of 15 faced (9 K's) in 4 IP to earn the win

STREAKIN: Noah Granet & Darren Hagan have both hit safely in each of the Lake Monsters first 7 games of the season

* Granet is 10-for-27 (.370) with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer and 7 RBI in 7 games, while Hagan has started season 8-for-28 (.286)

19K: Vermont pitchers combined to record 19 strikeouts in the season opener May 27th at Westfield with **Patrick Harrington** finishing with 9, while **Francis Ferguson** 7 and **Evan Stewart** 3
 * 19 strikeouts tied franchise record set twice in 2019, including vs Tri-City in final NY-Penn League season-opener for Monsters
 * Vermont batters struckout 19 times vs. Brockton June 1st, then struckout another 15 times in the loss to Brockton on June 2nd

LOCAL FLAVOR: 6 native Vermonters signed to play for Lake Monsters this season: **Wyatt Cameron** (Salisbury), **Ben Tate** (South Burlington), **Chase Carey** **Tom Vesosky** (both Colchester) with team, while **Leif Bigelow** (Guilford) joined the team Thursday and **Owen Kellington** (Plainsfield) after HS season
 * So far **Cameron, Carey and Tate** have a combined **0.00 ERA (10.1 IP, 7 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 6 BB, 5 SO)**, while **Vesosky** is **3-for-12 (.250)** with **2 runs, 1 triple, 2 RBI and 3 stolen bases in 3 games played**

ROSTER MOVES: Vermont added 3 players to the roster on Saturday: pitchers **Samuel Conte** (Trinity University) and **Steven Miller** (Penn State), along with infielder **Daniel Carinci** (Kansas State)

STEALIN': After just 3 stolen bases in first 5 games of the year, **Vermont has 14 stolen bases over the last 2 games** including 5 steals on 6/3 and 9 steals on 6/4 vs. Worcester

FCBL FIRSTS: **Noah Granet's** 3-run homer Saturday marked 1st-ever Lake Monsters FCBL home run ... **Caleb Jung** Vermont's 1st FCBL hit & RBI and **Darren Hagan** 1st run 5/27 at Westfield

FIELD STAFF: The Monsters 1st Futures League skipper is former Georgetown University coach **Pete Wilk**, who coached Hoyas for 21years (1999-2020), including former Lake Monsters **Nick Collins** '15-16 and **Jack Cushing** '19
