LAST NIGHT: Lake Monsters 2-3-1, New Britain 1-6-1

* Vermont scored its 2 runs in 5th inning, including the 1st without benefit of a hit with leadoff E6, 1-out HBP and 2-out Pat DeSalvo RBI fielder's choice scoring Daniel Carinci and Noah Granet (2-for-3) added an RBI single scoring Andrew Bergeron for 2-0 lead
 * Starter Patrick Harrington 4 scoreless innings with 3 hits, 3 walks and 4 strikeouts, while Tyler Fagler 1 run (top 7th) on 2 hits with 1 walk and 3 strikeouts over 3 innings of relief to earn the victory
 * Sammy Conte 1 hit and 3 strikeouts in the 8th inning, while Isaiah Rhodes struckout side in 9th for save in his Lake Monsters debut

WALKIN-n-STRIKIN: Vermont and Westfield combined for 22 walks and 25 strikeouts on Saturday (405 total pitches in game)

* Lake Monster had batters 14 walks and 17 strikeouts in win
 * Vermont pitchers recorded 17 strikeouts vs. New Britain Tuesday and have 10 or more strikeouts 7 of 11 games overall (19 on 5/27)
 * Lake Monsters batters 10 or more K last 4 games (8 of 11 overall)

WHAT A RELIEF: The Lake Monsters bullpen has 21 strikeouts over 10.1 innings in its last 2 games ... Tuesday vs. New Britain, bullpen 11 o last 12 outs by strikeout, while Wednesday vs. Bees the last 6 outs of game were recorded by strikeout

 * So far Bigelow, Cameron, Carey and Tate have a combined 1.62 ERA (16.2 IP, 14 H, 4 R, 3 ER, 10 BB, 7 SO), while Vesosky 5-for-25 (.200) with 4 R, 1 3B, 4 RBI and 3 SB in 7 games played

STEALIN': After just 3 stolen bases in first 5 games of the year, Vermont has 20 stolen bases over the last 6 games, including 5 steals on 6/3 and 9 stolen bases on 6/4 vs. Worcester

STREAKIN': Noah Granet has hit in 10 of 11 games (14x44, .318, 10 RBI), while Pat DeSalvo hit in 9 of first 11 games (14x45, .311)
 * Darren Hagan had an 8-game hitting streak (10x32, ..313) to start the season, but is 0-for-10 over last 3 games (drop avg to .238)
