* Vermont scored 3 runs on just 1 hit (leadoff single) in 2nd inning for 3-0 lead after 1-out walk and 3 straight 2-out walks forced 2 home before 3rd scored on Pat DeSalvo bases loaded hit by pitch
 * Lake Monsters made it 4-0 in 6th when Darren Hagan scored on an error and 5-1 in the 9th on a Jakob Bullard bases loaded walk
 * Starter Brett Hansen struckout 9 of first 14 batters faced, finishing with 1 hit, 1 walk and the 9 strikeouts over 4 scoreless innings
 * With a 3-run lead and 2 on/0 out in 7th, David Vial came on in relief to work out of jam with a popout and 2 groundouts

WHAT A RELIEF: The Lake Monsters bullpen has 23 strikeouts over 15.1 innings in its last 3 games ... Tuesday vs. New Britain, bullpen got 11 of last 12 outs by strikeout, while final 6 outs recorded Wednesday vs. Bees and first 5 outs Thursday vs. Rox by strikeout for stretch of 11 straight outs by strikeouts
 * For season, bullpen 81 strikeouts over 59.2 innings (12.22 per 9 IP)

STEALIN': After just 3 stolen bases in first 5 games of the year, Vermont has 20 stolen bases over the last 7 games, including 5 steals on 6/3 and 9 stolen bases on 6/4 vs. Worcester

6 STRAIGHT: Vermont has 6-game win streak for 1st time since August 23-27, 2018 when Lake Monster part of NY-Penn League.

STREAKIN': Noah Granet has hit in 11 of 12 games (15x48, .313, 10 RBI), while Pat DeSalvo hit in 9 of first 11 games (14x45, .311)
 * Darren Hagan had an 8-game hitting streak (10x32, .313) to start the season, but is 1-for-12 over last 4 games (drop avg to .250)

NEW MONSTERS: Lake Monsters have added 8 new players in the last week and expected to add infielder Chris Brown today after playing in NCAA Tourney with UConn (7-for-12 in 3 games)
 * Brown hit .298 (48x161), 31 R, 10 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 38 RBI overall
