LAST NIGHT: Worcester 4-8-3, Lake Monsters 0-4-1

* Worcester had a 3-run homer in the 4th inning for 4-0 advantage and held Vermont to just 1 hit (4th-inning bunt single) after 2nd inning
 * Lake Monsters best scoring chances came in first 2 innings as Vermont runners on 2nd-n-3rd with 1 out both innings, but were unable to score
 * Relievers Carson Walsh (1 strikeout) and Dylan Knightly (2 strikeouts) both tossed 2 scorelessinnings (Walsh in 6th/7th, Knightly in 8th/9th)
 * Jack Winnay was 2-for-4 with double, while Jordan Kang also doubled

BLANKED: Thursday marked 3rd time this season Vermont has been

shutout and all 3 have come here at Centennial Field vs. Worcester
 * The Bravehearts 4-1 at Centennial, while Vermont 4-0 at Worcester

A HIT ON THE ROAD: Over their last 8 road games (5-3 record),

Lake Monsters are hitting .297 (87x293) with 62 runs scored (7.75 rpg)
 * Last 9 home games (4-5), hitting .170 (41x241) with 31 runs (3.44 rpg)
 * For season, Vermont hitting .236 (217x922) at home and .271 (225x831) road

BIG INNINGS: While Vermont has a +101 run differential (330-229)

overall, Lake Monsters are +69 in 3rd & 4th innings combined (115-46)
 * Monsters outscoring opponents 64-25 in 3rd innings and 51-21 in the 4th
 * Vermont averaging 7.69 runs in its 35 wins and 2.77 runs in 22 losses

GOOD EYE: Vermont batters more BB than SO in 15 games this year

* Batters lead FCBL with most walks (306) & 2nd-fewest strikeouts (399), while pitchers have fewest walks (212) & 3rd-most strikeouts (491)

2-WAY OPTIONS: Pitcher Francis Ferguson, tied for FCBL lead in

wins (5), 2nd in ERA (2.44) and 4th in strikeouts (46) has also gone 9-for-28 (.321), 4 BB, 5 R, 4 RBI 11 games as starting leftfielder, DH or PH
 * Callen Fang (6 sv, 1.25 ERA) is 5-for-19 (.263, 2 R, 2B, 3 RBI) in 5 games batting

HAVE MERCY: With the 10-0, 6-inning win in game 2 Sunday, the

Lake Monsters have now won 6 games early by the 10-run "mercy rule"
 * That includes 3 early wins in 7-inning doubleheader games (10-0 on June 15th, 17-0 on June 25th (both 5-innings), while 10-0 in 6-innings Sunday
 * Vermont 15-1 last 3 years games decided by mercy rule (12-0 in last 2)

DOUBLE DIGITS: With 10 runs scored in game 2 Sunday, the Lake

Monsters have 10+ runs in 11 games (opponents 10+ runs once, 5/27)
 * Vermont has sent 9 or more batters to plate in 19 different innings, including 12 batters in the 3rd on 5/30, 14 in 8th 7/22 and 16 in 3rd 6/25

SUSPEND BELIEF: Along with 6 rainouts, the Lake Monsters have

had 4 other games suspended by rain (3 of those have been finished)
 * Will resume 7/21 game at Worcester on Saturday (VT lead 2-0 mid 4th)

2022, while 37-21 after 58 games in 2021 and 41-17 after 58 last season
