<u>2024 - Rice 66, Burlington 63</u>

Rice snapped tie with a 10-2 run for 62-54 lead with 1:36 left, then held on as BHS missed tying 3-pointer in final seconds ... Rice led by 7 after 1 period and at half before BHS 18-11 edge in 3rd tied game 46-46 ... Abdi Sharif had 23 points (7x12FG,9x12FT) and 9 rebounds, while Drew Bessette 9 points, 9 rebounds and 7 blocks for Rice ... Owen Eaton chipped in with 12 points and Grant Cieplicki 10 points and 9 rebounds ... Musa Kasagna 24 points, Pascal Munezero 14 points and Henry Tomwini 12 rebounds for Seahorses

2023 - CVU 42, Rice 38

Trailing by 9 points midway thru 3rd quarter, CVU used a 11-0 run to take 33-31 lead early 4th quarter, then after a Rice 3-pointer another 8-0 run to build 41-34 lead with just over minute left and held on to earn its 1st-ever D1 state title ... **Kyle Eaton** had game-high 19 points on trio of 3-pointers and 10-of-12 from foul line, while **Alex Provost** 9 points, 4 rebound and 4 steals ... **Tucker Tharpe** chipped in with 6 points and 10 rebounds for CVU, while **Adam Bilodeau** 11 points, 7 rebounds and **Drew Bessette** 10 rebounds for Rice

2022 - Rice 45, Rutland 41

After falling behind 10-0 to start game and 21-12 at half, Rice cut deficit to 34-32 end 3rd period and took lead for good at 37-36 with 4:08 left on its 1st 2-pt FG of game (had 9 3-pt FGs previously) ... Rice built 41-36 and 43-38 leads before clinching FT for 4-point lead with 3 seconds left ... Adam Bilodeau led Rice with 16 points (4-for-5 3-pt), while Drew Bessette 11 points, Mo Kanneh 10 rebounds, Sharif Sharif 4 assists ... Eli Pockette 20 points (4 3-pt) and 8 rebounds for Rutland, while Slade Postemski 11 boards and 4 blocks

2021 - Rice 71, South Burlington 46

Rice used a 16-2 run over final 3:02 of 1st quarter to open up a 28-12 lead and hit 7 3-point field goals in 1st half to take a 39-23 lead at the intermission ... Rice increased the lead to 20 points early in the 2nd half before leading 57-33 at end of the 3rd period and 65-37 midway thru 4th ... Sharif Sharif had game-high 20 points and Michel Ndayishimiye added 19 points for Rice, while Mo Awawyle and Judah Land 11 each ... Jonah Cattaneo led South Burlington with 18 points, while Tyler Gammons chipped in with 14 points.

2020 - Rice 53, St. Johnsbury 51

Michel Ndayishimiye had a game-high 20 points, including go ahead field goal with 32 seconds, while **Mo Awayle** had 17 points including 1 free throw for 2-point lead with 6 seconds left ... Ndayishimiye added 6 rebounds, 4 assists and 3 steals, while **Logan Wendell** led St. Johnsbury with 14 points ... Nick Gucklin added 11 points for SJA, while Andrew Cowan 9 points, 14 rebounds and 9 blocks ... SJA led by as many as 9 in 1st half before 17-9 Rice edge in 3rd quarter for 43-41 lead and Rice led by as many as 4 in 4th

2019 - St. Johnsbury 54, Rutland 50

Alex Carlisle scored 14 of his game-high 24 points in 3rd quarter as the Hilltoppers rallied from a 6-point deficit late in the 3rd period with a 12-5 run to take lead for good at 43-42 early in 4th ... SJA then stretched lead out to 7 points in the final minutes before Rutland 3-pointer in final seconds ... Carlisle added 8 rebounds, 3 assists and 2 blocked shots, while Asom Hayman-Jones had 12 points and 9 rebounds ... Jamieson Evans team-high 14 points for Rutland, while Jacob Lorman 12 points, 5 rebounds 4 blocks and 3 steals.

2018 - Rutland 45, Mt. Mansfield 39

Rutland completed a 23-0 season with its 2nd straight state title as **Jamison Evans** led the Raiders with 18 points (6-for-7 free throws, while **Jared Nelson** chipped in with 11 points ... **Noah Tyson** added 6 points, 8 rebounds and 4 steals for Rutland, while **Asa Carlson** had a game-high 14 points and 8 rebounds for Mt. Mansfield ... Rutland led by 4 at half and by as many as 8, 29-21, early in the 3rd quarter ... MMU was able to get as close as 37-36 with 3:55 remaining in the game before Rutland 6-0 run for 43-36 lead with 32 seconds left.

2017 - Rutland 43, CVU 37 (ot)

Rutland won its 1st state title since 1967 as Raiders scored first 6 points of overtime, including a **Nathaniel Kingsley** layup for a 39-35 lead with 47 seconds left ... Rutland led 33-26 in the 4th, but CVU ended with 9-2 run over final 5:44 of the period including a **Josh Bliss** layup with 40 seconds let to force overtime ... **Matt Lorman** had 18 points and 6 rebounds to lead the Raiders, while **Kyle Cassarino** added 9 and Kingsley 8 points ... Bliss had 10 points to lead CVU, while **Walker Storey** finished with 6 points and 9 rebounds.

2016 - Burington 37, Rice 29

Burlington erased an early 5-point 4th quarter deficit with an 11-0 run for a 31-25 with 3:27 left and outscored Rice 17-5 overall in the final period ... Rice had used runs of 9-0 and 11-0 to build a 22-16 lead with 4:15 left in the 3rd quarter ... Josh Hale led BHS with 11 points, while Kaden Rosamilia added 9 ... Kevin Garrison finishe with 8 points, 6 rebounds and 4 steals, while Asmin Mostarlic added 7 points and grabbed 10 rebounds ... Ben Shungu led Rice with 11 points, while Jack Fitzgerald 6 points, 4 rebounds, 4 steals

2015 - Rice 61, Burlington 54

Rice won 3rd straight title as **Kendrick Gray** had 19 points and 7 rebounds, while **Ben Shungu** added 16 points and 9 rebounds ... **Arnold Vainqueur** added 9 points and 8 rebounds for Rice, while **Feran Lopez** 9 points ... Rice led by 2 at half, held BHS without a FG in 3rd quarter and led 54-43 with 3:33 left ... But BHS cut deficit to 56-53 with 52 seconds left before 2 Shungu free throws and Gray dunk for 7-point lead ... **Asmin Mostarlic** led BHS with 16 points, while **Josh Hale** added 14 points and **Kevin Garrison** 10.

2014 - Rice 66, Mt. Mansfield 35

Ben Shungu had 18 points, 10 rebounds and 4 assists to lead Rice to its 2nd straight state title ... Rice led 18-7 late in 1st when Cougars went on 8-0 run to cut deficit to 3 points, but Rice used a 10-0 run for a 28-15 lead and led 32-17 at half ... Rice outscored MMU 25-12 in the 3rd quarter and built lead to as many as 31 before a 57-29 lead heading to the 4th ... **Tommy Fitzgerald** (4 assists) and **Kendrick Gray** both added 13 points for Rice ... **Tinga Adiang** had 14 points and 5 rebounds for Mt. Mansfield, while **Kyle Adams** 9 points.

2013 - Rice 48, St. Johnsbury 40 (ot)

Marcus Willingham led Rice with 17 points, 14 rebounds and 4 assists, while Casey Tipson added 14 points and James Wells scored 6 of his 10 points in the 4th quarter and overtime combined ... Rice's Tommy Fitzgerald sent the game to overtime on a field goal with 12 seconds left to tie the game at 37-37 ... St. Johnsbury's Vlad Cobzaru had 10 points and 10 rebounds before fouling out with 3:07 left in the 4th quarter, while Jake Grinbergs added 11 points and grabbed 9 rebounds for the previously unbeaten Hilltoppers.

2012 - Mt. Mansfield 41, Rice 34

Trailing by 5 at halftime, Mt. Mansfield outscored Rice 16-4 in the 3rd quarter and the Cougars shot 8-for-13 from the field in the 2nd half to win their 4th state title ... Tom Lacy had 11 points and 10 rebounds to lead Mt. Mansfield, while Troy Springer scored all 9 of his points in the 2nd half ... Eric Suder added 8 points and had 8 rebounds, while T.J. Wesson had 8 points for the Cougars ... Casey Tipson led Rice with 16 points, while Tim Rensch 9 points and 14 rebounds as Rice scoreless for 5:27 stretch in 3rd quarter.

2011 - Rice 55, Rutland 48

The 7th and final lead change in the last 5:14 of game came on back-to-back field goals from **Austin Robinson** as Rice took a 48-45 lead into the final minute of the contest ... Robinson had 19 points and 4 assists, while **Christian McCormack** also had 19 points and **Jake Maynard** hit a pair of 4th quarter 3-pointers for Rice ... Rutland scored the first 2 points of the 4th for a 38-33 lead, but were outscored 22-12 rest of quarter ... **Troy Davine** had 13 points to lead the Raiders, while **Alex Snyder** 10 points and 13 rebounds.

2010 - Essex 44, Burlington 37

Demir Smajovic had 12 points and 10 rebounds to lead the Hornets to the state title over the top-seeded Seahorses ... **Chris Bogue** added 10 points, including 6 straight in the 3rd quarter for a 28-21 Essex lead ... **Ben Ferris** had 9 points and grabbed 11 rebounds, while **Josh Stewart** 9 points for the Hornets ... Essex led 16-14 at the half and 30-28 at the end of the 3rd before pulling away late ... **Joe O'Shea** had a game-high 23 points and grabbed 12 rebounds for Burlington, but rest of Seahores just 6-for-34 from the field.

2009 - Rice 48, Burlington 39 (ot)

Jon Goldberg had 21 points, 8 rebounds, 6 assists and forced overtime when he tied the game 35-35 on a field goal with just 2.6 seconds left in the 4th quarter before scoring 10 points (8-of-10 from foul line) in overtime ... Nick Meunier added 14 points and 11 rebounds for Rice, while David Gagne had 8 points and grabbed 6 rebounds ... Clancy Rugg led Seahorses with 14 points and 9 rebounds, while James Hale added 10 points and had 4 rebounds for BHS ... The loss snapped a 46-game winning streak for Burlington.

<u> 2008 - Burlington 49, Rice 33</u>

The Seahorses used an 11-0 run over end of the 1st quarter and the start of the 2nd for an 18-13 lead, then led 25-18 lead at the half and held Rice to just 2 field goals in the 3rd quarter for a 34-22 lead ... **Clancy Rugg** led Burlington with 13 points, 7 rebounds and 3 blocked shots, while **Tyler Barron** had 14 points as Burlington completed the 1st Division 1 undefeated season since 1983 ... **Jonathan Goldberg** had 13 points and 6 rebounds for Rice, whose 33 points were the fewest by losing team in the Division 1 finals since 1972.

2007 - Rice 40, Burlington 37

Gael Shungu scored all 15 of his points in the 1st half, while **Ben Gagne** added 10 points and 9 rebounds to lead Rice to the state title ... Gagne scored the final 8 points of the game for Rice, including 2 free throws with 10.7 seconds left for the 3-point lead ... **Tyrone Conley** had 21 points to lead Burlington, but his 3-point attempt with 3 seconds left to tie game was no good ... Rice led 30-20 midway through the 3rd quarter before a 17-6 BHS run gave the Seahorses a 37-36 lead, but Burlington then held scoreless final 4:44 of game.

2006 - Burlington 56, Spaulding 36

Tyrone Conley had 20 points (going 9-for-18 from field), 7 rebounds and 4 steals, while **Louis Williams** added 8 points and 6 rebounds for the Seahorses ... BHS led 24-17 at half-time, then used an 18-6 run during the 3rd quarter for a 42-23 lead heading into the 4th ... **J.J. Holmes** had 9 points, while **Andrew Plumley** 6 points and 7 rebounds for Burlington ... **Jon Chaloux** led Spaulding with 15 points, 9 points in the 4th quarter), while **Chrispatrick Cox, Justin Rouleau** and **Jeff Rouleau** each had 5 points for the Tide.

2005 - Mt. Mansfield 43, Spaulding 37

Matt Glass had 27 points, going 8-for-16 from the field and 11-for-14 from the foul line, while grabbing 14 rebounds to lead Mt. Mansfield to back-to-back state titles ... Mt. Mansfield led 15-14 at halftime, but then Spaulding's **Josh Dickinson** (14 points) scored 8 straight points to give the Tide a 32-27 lead with 6:58 left in the game ... Glass, who scored 20 of the Cougars 28 points in the 2nd half, had 10 points during a 16-5 MMU run over the final 6:58 ... **David Ausmann** 6 points and grabbed 10 rebounds for Spaulding.

2004 - Mt. Mansfield 46, Burlington 45

Chad Powlovich had 12 points, 9 rebounds, 5 assists and 4 steals, including a steal and 2 free throws with 1:20 left to give Mt. Mansfield the 46-45 lead ... BHS had chance to tie the game with 6.5 seconds left, but were called for a lane violation on a free throw attempt ... Jay McPeters added 15 points and 9 rebounds for the Cougars, who led 23-21 at the half ... Geri Guillory led Burlington with 25 points (11-for-20 from field), including 14 of the Seahorses first 16 points of the 2nd half ... Chris Hudson scored 13 points for BHS.

2003 - Burlington 55, Colchester 40

Geri Guillory scored 25 points, grabbed 8 rebounds and had 3 assists to lead Burlington to the state title ... Peadi Bevins, Shaun Collette and C.J. Walsh each added 6 points for the Seahorses ... Burlington led 29-22 at the half before Colchester cut the defecit to 35-33 late in the 3rd period ... After a BHS 3-pointer to end the 3rd, the Seahorses outscored Colchester 17-7 in the 4th quarter to pull away for the title ... Tommy Howe led Colchester with 15 points, while Chris Walker 10 points and Manny Herceg 9 points.

2002 - Spaulding 65, Brattleboro 55

4 players scored in double figures as Spaulding won its 1st state title since 1994 season ... **Kurt Forcier** led the Tide with 16 points, while **Mike Perez** 15 points and **Michael Blouin** added 14 points ... **David Ball** also scored 14 points, including 4 dunks, for Spaulding ... Brattleboro got within 4 points at 57-53 in the final minute, but Spaulding hit 8 straight free throws (including 6 by Forcier) ... **Kyle Henry** had 16 points and 6 rebounds to lead Brattleboro, while **Chris Cassidy** added 15 points and **Will Holiday** 10 points.

2001 - Burlington 79, Spaulding 74

B.J. Robertson led 4 Seahorses in double figures with 23 points and 12 rebounds, including 14 straight BHS points at start of 4th quarter after Spaulding had cut the Burlington lead to 57-55 ... **Muji Karim** added 21 points, including a 3-pointer with 2:03 left for a 74-68 BHS lead (Spaulding was able to get within 76-72 with 45 seconds left) ... **Derek Trono** chipped in with 15 points and **Husain Karim** added 11 for BHS ... **Michael Perez** led Spaulding with 22 points, while Kurt Forcier had 17 points and **David Ball** 13 points.

<u>2000 - Rice 78, Burlington 62</u>

Mike Cioffi had a game-high 23 points, including 12 points in the 3rd quarter when Rice used a 12-0 run over the final 4:09 of period to erase a 47-46 BHS lead and take a 58-47 advantage into the 4th quarter ... The closest the Seahorses could get in the 4th was 68-60 with 3:51 left ... Andrew McDonald added 16 points and Nick Landrigan 12 points for Rice, while Alex Lloyd chipped in with 14 points, 11 rebounds and 5 blocked shots ... Muji Karim led Burlington with 19 points, while Jed Thibault chipped in 15 points.

1999 - MSJ 66, Burlington 52

MSJ jumped out to a 20-point halftime lead before the Seahorses cut the deficit to 2 points late in game, but the Mounties went 10-for-10 from the free throw line in the final 2 minutes to become the first 6th-seed to win D1 boy's state title ... MSJ built a 30-19 lead at the half, but Burlington rallied to within 54-52 with 2:01 left before the Mounties went on a 12-0 run to end game ... Jeff Wetherby had 17 points, Michael Keenan 15 and Tom McCann 14 to lead MSJ ... Jed Thibault had 21 points and Alex Tonne 13 for BHS.

1998 - Essex 64, Brattleboro 57 (ot)

The Hornets trailed 17-1 after the 1st quarter, but stormed back to tie game in final minute and took its 1st lead of game 30 seconds into overtime before hitting 13-of-17 free throws in OT for win ... Matt Sheftic led Essex with 21 points and 17 rebounds, while Cam Robinson added 15 points ... Ben Gilbert had 20 points and Jeff Dixon 17 points for Colonels ... Essex outscored Brattleboro 16-8 in 2nd quarter for a 25-17 deficit at the half, then tied game late in 4th before the Colonels missed 2 free throw attempts with 7 seconds left.

1997 - St. Johnsbury 65, Burlington 51

Tony Orciari scored 27 points and made 5 three-pointers in the 2nd half ... After Burlington scored the first 2 points of game, the Hilltoppers went on a 15-0 run and led by as many as 20 in the 2nd period before 33-20 halftime lead ... BHS cut the lead to either 3 or 4 points on 3 different occasions in 2nd half, but Orciari answered with a 3-pointer each time ... **Aurie Thibault** led Burlington with 19 points, while **Manny Robertson** had 9 points and 8 rebounds ... **Jay O'Brien** 8 points, 6 assists and 5 steals for the Seahorses.

1996 - Burlington 79, Rice 70

The Seahorses won their 1st state championship in 19 years as **Manny Robertson** had 18 points, grabbed 19 rebounds and blocked 6 shots ... After BHS led 37-31 at halftime and 58-49 after 3 quarters, Rice cut deficit to 60-58 before 6-0 Burlington run for 66-58 led with 3:55 left ... **Seth Smith** and **Justin Pecor** both had 15 points for BHS, while **Adam Provost** scored 18 of his 20 points in the 2nd half for Rice ... **Josh Carpentier** added 18 points, while **Adam LaWare** had 11 points and grabbed 19 rebounds for Little Indians.

<u>1995 - Mt. Mansfield 43, St. Johnsbury 40</u>

The Cougars won their 1st ever state championship as **Seth Shamp** led Mt. Mansfield with 12 points and 20 rebounds ... After 4 free throws from **Corey Hevrin** in the final minute gave the Cougars a 41-40 lead, St. Johnsbury missed a 3point field goal attempt with just 6 seconds left and **Adam Bovill** gave Mt. Mansfield the 43-40 lead with 2 more free throws with 2 seconds remaining ... St. Johnsbury's **Tony Orciari** led all scorers with 21 points, going 7-for-12 from the field while rest of Hilltoppers just 7-for-35 from field.

1994 - Spaulding 78, Burlington 67

Matt George scored 43 points as Spaulding won its 1st state title in 30 years ... George scored 20 points during a 22-2 Spaulding run over a 6:11 stretch of the 1st half to give Tide a 30-18 lead ... BHS rallied to take a 39-38 lead early in 3rd quarter, but Spaulding retook a 53-50 lead after 3 periods and finished 20-of-24 from the foul line in 2nd half ... Chris Rossi added 12 points and Mike Jarvis scored 11 points for the Tide ... Craig Emmons led Burlington with 26 points, while Kevin Jackson chipped in 13 points and 14 rebounds.

1993 - Brattleboro 58, Rutland 44

The 7th-seeded Colonels used a 50-22 rebounding edge as **Sjoerd de Jong** led Brattleboro with 16 points and had 9 rebounds, while **Trevor Golding** added 14 points and **Chris Costello** 11 points for the Colonels ... Rutland led 16-10 early in the 2nd quarter before a 15-1 Brattleboro run for a 25-17 Colonel lead ... Rutland cut a 42-30 deficit after 3 quarters to 46-39 with 4:09 left, but Brattleboro went 10-for-14 from the free throw line over final 3 minutes to seal the title ... **Jim Anagnos** scored 15 points to lead the Raiders.

1992 - Mt. Anthony 56, Colchester 51 (ot)

The Patriots scored the final 6 points of regulation and all 5 overtime points to rally for their 5th staight state title ... The Lakers led 42-32 after 3 quarters before Mt. Anthony scored the first 11 points of 4th period for a 43-42 lead ... Lakers took a 51-45 lead with 1:49 remaining in the 4th, but **Jeremy Davis** (24 points) hit back-to-back 3-pointers to tie the game with 41 seconds left in regulation ... **Alan Laroche** led Colchester with 15 points, 10 rebounds and 7 assists, while **Aaron Stine** 14 points and 11 rebounds for the Lakers.

1991 - Mt. Anthony 68, Colchester 56

Mt. Anthony won its 4th straight state title behind **David Christie's** 21 points and 7 rebounds, while **Brian Friel** added 13 points and **Chad Pierce** 12 points for the Patriots ... The Lakers led 19-15 after the 1st quarter, but outscored 35-21 over the 2nd and 3rd periods for a 50-40 MAU lead ... The Patriots led by 12 early in 4th before a 9-0 Colchester run cut lead to 54-41, but Mt. Anthony 10-of-12 free throws down stretch ... **Adam Laroche** had 21 points and 5 assists for Colchester, while **Steve Cacciola** chipped in 20 points.

1990 - Mt. Anthony 64, Rice 60

David Christie scored 23 points (9-of-12 from field) and grabbed 12 rebounds as the Patriots won their 3rd straight title ... Rice led 44-43 after 3 quarters and were leading 58-55 with 2:50 left in the 4th before Christie, who scored 9 of his 23 points in the period, put Mt. Anthony ahead for good 59-58 with 1:50 remaining ... **Dan Sleeman** added 15 points and **Bill Cone** 13 points for Patriots ... **Bernie Cieplicki** led Rice with 15 points, including 9 in the 3rd quarter), while **Kurt Mayr** added 11 points and **Russ Kembel** 10 points.

<u> 1989 - Mt. Anthony 101, South Burlington 64</u>

The Patriots shot 58% from the field and hit 26-of-34 foul shots to set a title game scoring record ... Tied 28-28 midway through the 2nd quarter, Mt. Anthony went on a 19-8 run for a 47-36 halftime lead and led 69-50 after 3 periods ... Todd Haynes had 29 points (10-of-14 FG) and 8 rebounds for MAU ... Andy Nutting added 23 points (9-of-13 FG) and 7 rebounds, while Jay Crosier had 17 points and 7 assists ... Steve Blouin led Rebels with 20 points and 7 rebounds, while Sean Benoit scored 12 points and had 8 rebounds.

1988 - Mt. Anthony 71, Rice 68

Sean Lalley scored a team-high 23 points, including the go ahead basket with 1:08 left as Mt. Anthony snapped a 65-65 tie with a 6-0 run before Rice hit a 3-pointer at the buzzer ... Rice had led by as many as 11 points in the 1st half before setting for a 37-30 lead at halftime before the Patriots tied the game 52-52 after 3 quarters ... Jay Crosier had 16 points and 4 assists for MAU ... Peter Marcoux scored 16 of his game-high 25 points in the first half and pulled down 14 rebounds for Little Indians, while Brian Tarrant 18 points.

1987 - BFA-St. Albans 50, Colchester 48 (ot)

Matt Johnson scored 22 points, including all 6 BFA points in the overtime at the foul line, to lead the Bobwhites to their 1st title since 1959 ... Johnson hit 14-of-15 free throws for the game as BFA led 23-21 at halftime and then saw Lakers rally from a 6-point deficit in the final minute of regulation to send game into overtime tied 44-44 on a basket with 6 seconds remaining ... **Mike Baumann** led Colchester with 22 points, 9 rebounds and 5 blocks, including 9-of-13 shooting from the field, while rest of Colchester went 10-of-34.

1986 - Brattleboro 60, St. Johnsbury 59

The Colonels won their 1st-ever state title after taking a 52-33 lead into the 4th quarter before needing **Jason Coplan** to hit the 1st of 2 free throws with 15 seconds left for a 1-point lead and escaping after St. Johnsbury missed a pair of free throws with no time left on the clock ... The Hilltoppers had trailed 59-47 with 2:20 remaining in the game before going on a 12-0 run to tie game at 59-59 with 39 seconds left ... **Tom James** had 19 points to lead the Colonels, while **Jim Howe** led all of the St. Johnsbury scorers with 17 points.

1985 - Rice 51, BFA-St. Albans 50 (ot)

Tim Gamache, who led the Little Indians with 17 points and 11 rebounds, put Rice ahead for good on a put-back basket with 16 seconds left in overtime ... Rice used a 22-12 2nd quarter for a 32-28 lead at half before the teams combined for 9 lead changes during the 2nd half ... 1984 - MSJ 63, Rutland 52

After trailing by 2 points at the half, MSJ outscored Rutland 35-22 in the 2nd half to win its 1st state title since 1954 ... The Mounties had a 25-12 advantage at the foul line, including 8 straight free throws in the final 1:35 after Rutland cut a deficit to 3 points, 55-52 ... **Rob Parento** led MSJ in scoring with 17 points ... **Greg Maslak** added 15 points and 9 rebounds, while 3 other Mounties had 8 points ... **Craig Susmann** led the Raiders with 12 points and 12 rebounds.

1983 - Middlebury 73, St. Johnsbury 57

Rob Hamlin scored 42 points, while **Joe Calavita** chipped in 16 points and 16 rebounds as the Tigers completed an undefeated season and snapped Hilltoppers 2-year title reign ... Hamlin was 17-for-28 from the field for the game, including 11-for-15 in the 1st half as Middlebury built a 39-24 halftime lead ... They increased lead to 21 points, 56-35, after 3 quarters before St. Johnsbury got as close as 9 points, 60-51, with 15-4 run in 4th quarter ... **Henry Dalrymple** had 33 points (13-for-23 FG) and 23 rebounds for Hilltoppers.

1982 - St. Johnsbury 72, Mt. Anthony 67 (20t)

Henry Dalrymple scored a Division 1 title game record 55 points, grabbed 22 rebounds, blocked 3 shots and also had 7 steals to lead St. Johnsbury to back-to-back state titles ... Dalrymple was 25-for-37 from the field and outrebounded the entire Patriots team 22-18 ... A Dalrymple field goal with 1:53 left forced OT, had a steal with 2 seconds left to force the 2nd OT and then scored 8 straight points for a 71-64 lead with 37 seconds left in 2nd overtime ... Bill Colvin had 25 points and Chip Hoag added 15 points for Mt. Anthony.

1981 - St. Johnsbury 62, Rutland 47

Henry Dalrymple had 19 points (9-of-14 from field) and 17 rebounds, while **Rory Grimes** (6 assists) and **Shawn Philpot** (7-of-10 from field) both had 15 points as St. Johnsbury won its 1st state title ... The Hilltoppers led 30-22 at halftime before Rutland cut deficit to 39-35 with 2:42 left in 3rd ... St. Johnsbury scored 6 straight and led 49-39 heading into 4th period, where they used a 9-2 run over first 5:30 for a 58-41 lead ... Jim McCaffery, who had scored 48 points in semifinal win, led Rutland with 19 point in final.

1980 - Rice 64, Rutland 57

Keith Cieplicki scored 13 of his game-high 25 points in the 4th quarter to lead Little Indians to 1st state title since 1971 ... Mike Brassard added 21 points for Rice, going 8-for-11 from the field and 5-for-6 at the line ... The Little Indians led 31-29 at break, but opened 2nd half with 14-4 run and led 47-38 after 3 quarters ... The Raiders cut the deficit to 57-54 with 2:17 left, but Cieplicki 3-point play started 7-0 run for 10-point advantage ... Kevin O'Neill 16 points for Rutland, while Jeff Brewer and Jim McCaffery both had 12 points.

1979 - Essex 69, Rice 67

Trailing 63-51 with 5:13 left in the game, the Hornets ran off 14 straight points to take a 65-63 lead with 3:25 remaining before snapping a 65-65 tie on field goals with 1:09 and 25 seconds left ... Rice cut deficit to 2 points on a basket with 18 seconds left, but missed a potential game-tying shot with 2 seconds remaining ... John Wisehart had 23 points and 17 rebounds for Essex, while Jeff Pantow added 21 points ... Keith Cieplicki had game-high 27 points before fouling out with 3:32 left, while Mike Brassard 18 points, 13 rebounds.

1978 - Windsor 73, Rice 64

Windsor won its 1st state title in 1st final since 1959 as **Paul Righi** scored 24 points and had 10 rebounds ... **Lyle Coffran** scored all 13 of his points in 1st half as the Wasps took a 28-25 lead, but trailed by 2 points in 3rd quarter before a 9-0 run gave Windsor a 40-33 lead ... Rice could not get any closer than 5 points, 48-43, at the end of the 3rd ... **Shawn Marden** had 18 points for Windsor, while **Keith Cieplicki** had 21 points to lead Rice ... **Bob Limanek** added 13 points and 15 rebounds for the Little Indians, while **Ed McNeill** 11 points.

1977 - Burlington 56, Mt. Anthony 54

Mike Hartnett had 20 points and 8 rebounds, while **Bruce Beynnon** added 13 points and 10 rebounds to lead Burlington to the state title ... The Seahorses built a 30-22 lead at halftime and led 51-44 before a 6-0 MAU run cut the lead to 51-50 with 1:05 left in the game ... Trailing 56-54 the Patriots had 2 chances in the final seconds to tie game, but a turnover and a missed shot at buzzer came up short ... **Peter Geannelis** led Mt. Anthony with 17 points (9-of-10 free throws), while **Scott McGuire** 12 of his 16 points in 1st half.

1976 - Mt. Anthony 65, Burlington 63

Alan Daigneault's field goal with 6 seconds left snapped a 63-63 tie and gave Patriots their 3rd straight title ... Neither team led by more than 4 points from the midway point of the 2nd quarter ... BHS led 49-46 after 3 quarters, but needed field goal with 1:16 left to tie game at 63 ... Ron Pembroke had 16 points to lead Mt. Anthony, while Daigneault added 14 and Peter Geannelis scored all 13 of his points in 2nd half ... Tom Carter was 10-of-15 from field to score 20 points for Burlington, while Bruce Beynnon had 13 points.

1975 - Mt. Anthony 94, Springfield 67

Mitch Burke scored 24 points, going 10-for-15 from the field, and grabbed 7 rebounds as the Patriots outscored the Cosmos 34-18 in the 4th period ... Alan Daigneault had 19 points and Russ Pembroke 14 points for MAU, while Jim Maguire had 13 points and 11 rebounds for Patriots ... MAU led 41-29 at half and 60-49 after 3 quarters before outscoring Springfield by 16 in the 4th quarter ... Greg Birsky was 11-of-17 from field for 22 points to lead Springfield, while Tony Klementowicz had 14 points and grabbed 8 rebounds.

1974 - Mt. Anthony 68, Bellows Falls 57

After falling behind by 4 points early in the 4th quarter, the Patriots used a 12-0 run over the next 3 minutes for a 55-47 lead and after a Bellows Falls basketball ran off another 6 straight points for a 61-49 lead ... Mt. Anthony had led 30-26 at the half and 42-40 after 3 quarters before the Terriers used a 7-0 spurt to take a 47-43 lead ... Walt Parmenter led Mt. Anthony with 20 points, while Jim Maguire added 18 points and grabbed 23 rebounds ... Mike Eno had 20 points and Boby Noyes added 18 points to lead Bellows Falls.

1973 - Burlington 40, MSJ 34

Rob Snow and **Bob Sweeney** both scored a game-high 12 points as the Seahorses used a 6-0 run in the 3rd quarter to open up a 26-22 lead and held on for the state title ... BHS led 32-28 after 3 quarters before the 2 teams swapped baskets until Burlington used back-to-back field goals with 1:40 and 1:13 remaining to take a 40-32 lead ... **Dave Walker** led the Mounties with 11 points, while **Skip Pratico** added 9 points ... **Dan Blanchard** had 10 rebounds for Burlington, while **John Shaw** grabbed game-high 11 rebounds for MSJ.

1972 - Burlington 43, Montpelier 33

Bob Sweeney had a game-high 19 points, including 9 points in the 2nd period as the Seahorses outscored Solons 16-12 to take a 22-19 lead ... BHS built the lead to 34-23 after 3 quarters before Montpelier answered with 6 straight points to cut deficit to 34-29 before going scoreless for 3 and 1/2 minutes as BHS scored 5 straight for 39-29 lead ... **Dave Bove** had 7 points and 6 rebounds for Burlington, while **Mike Evarts** grabbed 8 rebounds ... **Peter Dale** led Montpelier with 8 points and 7 rebounds, while **Brent Miller** also had 8 points.

<u>1971 - Rice 56, Burlington 37</u>

Jim Limenek hit 7-of-9 shots from floor in scoring a gamehigh 14 points and grabbed 11 rebounds leading Rice to 2nd straight title ... **John O'Brien** (19 rebounds) and **Jimmy Merola** both had 12 points for the Little Indians ... Rice jumped out to a quick 10-2 lead and built a 28-15 halftime lead before leading by as many as 17 (38-21) in the 3rd quarter ... BHS cut deficit to 12 at start of 4th, but a 9-0 run gave Rice 48-27 advantage ... **Dave Bove** led Burlington with 12 points, while **Kevin Carney** had 6 points and 10 rebounds.

1970 - Rice 59, Montpelier 39

John O'Brien had 22 points and 17 rebounds as the Little Indians outrebounded the Solons 54-29 overall ... Rice led 16-13 early in the 2nd quarter before using a 19-6 spurt for a 35-19 lead at halftime ... Montpelier was able to cut the defict to 42-33 with 7 minutes left, but Rice closed out the contest with a 17-6 run for the 20-point victory ... Joe Gamache had 15 points and 12 rebounds, while Tim Shea 12 points for Rice ... Paul Bowles team-high 11 points for Montpelier, while Steve Donnelly 4 points and 10 rebounds.

1969 - Burlington 43, Rice 37

Brad Steele and **Chuck Copp** both scored a game-high 15 points as BHS outscored the unbeaten Little Indians 12-4 in the 4th quarter to win its 1st state title since 1955 ... Rice led 24-17 at halftime before the Seahorses used an 8-1 run to tie game at 25-25 ... Later tied 35-35, Steele hit a pair of field goals with 57 and 35 seconds remaining to give BHS 4-point lead ... **Dennis McKenzie** 11 points and **Max McKenzie** 9 points for Rice, which hit just 4-of-25 shots in the 2nd half and its only field goal in 4th quarter came in final seconds.

1968 - Rice 91, Springfield 53

After leading 38-34 at halftime, Rice outscored the Cosmos 53-19 in the 2nd half for the 38-point victory ... 5 Little Indians scored in double figures led by **Max McKenzie** with 20 points and 11 rebounds ... **George Thabault** added 16 points and 10 rebounds for Rice, while **Curt Cline** 14 points and **Ed Harrington** 13 ... Rice outscored Springfield 25-12 in the 3rd quarter for 63-46 lead and then 28-7 in 4th period ... **Parry Williams** led Springfield with 19 points, while **Duff Lorinovich** had 13 points and **Jeff Dick** 14 rebounds.

1967 - Rutland 47, Bennington Catholic 45

The Red Raiders used a 7-0 run late in the game to snap the Sabers 3-year reign as state champion ... The game was tight throughout with Rutland leading 21-19 at half and tied 34-34 after 3 quarters ... Bennington Catholic led 41-40 when Rutland got a layup with 1:40 remaining to take the lead and added 5 more points over the next minute to take a 47-31 lead ... Bob Pratt led the Raiders with 17 points, while Joe Phillips added 13 points for Rutland ... Bill Brooks had 17 points and Don Chaffin 14 points for Bennington Catholic.

1966- Bennington Catholic 60, Rice 44

After leading by just 2 points after the 1st period, the Sabers outscored Rice 33-13 during the 2nd and 3rd quarters for a 49-27 lead to clinch 2nd straight title ... **Stan Krawczyk** led Sabers with 15 points and 15 rebounds, while **Don Chaffin** 11 points ... **Tom Caron** added 9 points and 11 rebounds for Bennington Catholic ... Little Indians were outscored 19-5 in the 2nd period (3-of-13 at foul line) and got no closer than 14 points late in the 4th ... **Butch Burdick** led Rice with 11 points, while **Bambi Lefebvre** 10 points and 11 rebounds.

1965- Bennington Catholic 60, Spaulding 48

The Sabers outscored Spaulding 16-8 during the 2nd quarter to take a 29-18 halftime advantage as Bennington Catholic snapped the Crimon Tide's 4-year title reign with its 1st-ever state title ... Bennington Catholic increased the lead to 47-32 after 3 quarters with Spaulding not able to get any closer than a 10-point deficit during the 4th ... **Pete Lemieux** had a game-high 19 points for the Sabers, while **Pete Tocci** added 15 points and **Tom Caron** 11 points ... **Jeff Plunkett** had 14 points and **Don Fitts** added 13 points to lead Crimson Tide.

1964 - Spaulding 71, Springfield 61

The Crimson Tide snapped a 54-54 tie with 5 straight points in just a 2-second span during a 7-0 run and captured their 4th straight state title ... Spaulding outscored the Cosmos 24-14 in 3rd quarter for 54-46 lead before Springfield 8-0 run at start of 4th tying game at 54 ... After the 7-0 run Springfield cut Spaulding lead to 63-59 with 2 minutes left, but the Tide scored 6 straight for 10-point lead ... **Dick Darling** and **Ernie Henes** both had 16 points for Spaulding, while Don Fitts 15 points ... **Bob Lorinovich** 16 points for Springfield.

1963 - Spaulding 62, Bellows Falls 41

Mike Calevro scored 16 of his game-high 19 points in the 2nd half and **Frankie Wilson** scored 11 of his 15 points in the 1st half as Spaulding became the 1st team in 41 years to win 3 straight state titles ... The Crimson Tide used a 13-0 run for an early 15-2 lead and led 32-20 at half ... Spaulding increased the lead to 15 points, 45-30, after 3 periods and led by as many as 23 points in the 4th quarter ... **Dave Hale** chipped in 14 points for Spaulding, while **Vin DiBernardo** had 12 points and **John Buckley** 10 points for Bellows Falls.

1962 - Spaulding 79, Springfield 69

Layne Higgs had 19 points and Mike Calevro 18 points to lead the Crimson Tide to the victory in a close-knit final ... Spaulding led by 2 points after the 1st period (19-17) and halftime (40-38), then 4 points after 3 quarters (59-55) ... The Tide still led by just 5 points with 3 minutes left before 2 free throws and a layup gave Spaulding a 75-66 lead ... Sandy Johnson added 14 points and Dale Mudgett 12 for the Tide, while John French had a game-high 20 points and Bill Abrahamovich 13 points in the loss for the Cosmos.

1961 - Spaulding 58, Bellows Falls 51

Romero Aja scored 10 of his game-high 20 points in the 4th quarter to lead the Crimson Tide to its 1st state title since 1951 ... Layne Higgs added 13 points and Butch Cassani 10 points for Spaulding ... The Terriers had a 16-12 lead after the 1st period, but Spaulding outscored Bellows Falls 18-9 in the 2nd for a 30-25 halftime lead ... The Crimson Tide, who were 22-of-28 from the foul line, increased the lead to 41-33 after 3 quarters ... Fran Bigelow had 13 points for Bellows Falls and Larry Byrnes chipped in with 11 points.

1960 - Springfield 44, BFA-St. Albans 42

Mike Sheehan scored 11 of his team-high 14 points in the 4th quarter as Springfield outscored BFA 11-6 over the final 4:20 to rally from a 38-33 deficit ... Sheehan had a field goal with 1:11 left and then hit a free throw with 22 seconds remaining to give the Cosmos a 43-40 advantage ... After a Bobwhite field goal and Springfield free throw, BFA missed game-tying shot at the buzzer ... **Ken Baker** added 13 points and **Cleon Morse** 11 points for Springfield ... **Ollie Dunlap** accounted for half of BFA's 42 points with a game-high 21.

1959 - BFA-St. Albans 72, Windsor 47

Ollie Dunlap and **Pete Voytek** both scored a game-high 19 points, including combined 19 points in 3rd quarter for a 20-point lead heading into 4th period ... After tight 1st quarter, BFA opened up a 31-17 halftime lead ... **Joe Pare** chipped in 14 points for Bobwhites, while **Bobby Blake** had team-high 15 points and **Taylor Carter** added 12 points for Windsor.

1958 - Rutland 44, BFA-St. Albans 34

Ernie Ruppe had a game-high 21 points to lead Rutland to state title ... Red Raiders led 24-18 at half and 32-23 after 3 quarters before BFA cut deficit to 35-31 midway through 4th quarter ... Rutland ended game with 9-3 run ... **Bernie Mangan** added 10 points for Rutland, while **Ollie Dunlap** had 13 points and **Pete Voytek** 10 ppoints for the Bobwhites.

1957 - Springfield 43, Burlington 38

Springfield won its 2nd straight state title as the Cosmos held a 21-19 lead at halftime and built the lead to 33-28 as **Don Emerson** scored 5 of his game-high 13 points in the 3rd quarter ... **Burlington** cut the deficit to 37-36 with 2:02 left, but Springfield hit 6 free throws in final 2 minutes ... **Bunny Bisaillon** had 9 points and **Jim Holmes** 8 for BHS.

1956 - Springfield 44, Montpelier 43

Dave Stern scored a game-high 15 points, including 2 free throws for a 44-41 Springfield lead with 15 seconds left ... The Cosmos led 17-10 after 1 quarter, 27-24 at half and 40-34 heading into the 4th period ... **Brad Dunbar** chipped in 13 points and **Chuck Collier** 10 points for Springfield, while **Bob Yates** had a team-high 12 points for Montpelier.

1955 - Burlington 72, Springfield 46

Burlington outscored Cosmos 42-23 in 2nd half for 26-point victory ... Tied 21-21 with 3:42 left in 2nd, BHS 9-2 run for 30-23 lead at half before outscoring Cosmos 18-10 in 3rd and 24-13 in 4th ... John Lambert game-high 21 points for BHS, while Jerry Thibault added 16 and Reg Valley 14 ... Glen Stearns had 14 points and Dave Stern 12 for Cosmos.

<u> 1954 - MSJ 50, Cathedral 42</u>

MSJ won its 1st-ever state title using a 13-5 edge in 2nd period for 19-10 halftime lead ... After 48 total points (30-18 MSJ thru 3 quarters), teams combined for 44 points in 4th as Cathedral cut a 45-25 deficit to 49-36 with 1:21 left ... **Basil Nichols** had 13 points and **Bob Gilliam** 12 for MSJ ... **Ralph St. Peter** 15 points and **Ron Bouchard** 10 for Rice.

<u>1953 - Burlington 56, MSJ 52</u>

The Seahorses won their 10th state title in 30 years as **Tom Atherton** had game-high 17 points, while **Fred McClellan** added 11 points and **Art Lambert** 10 ... BHS led by 6 points after 1st period (21-15), at half (29-23) and after 3 quarters (40-34) ... MSJ cut deficit to 49-45 with 2:48 left, but BHS 4 straight points ... **Ronnie Richards** had 14 points for MSJ.

1952 - Rutland 42, Spaulding 36

Rutland snapped Spaulding's 2-year title reign, using 13-5 scoring edge in both 2nd and 4th periods ... Raiders trailed 35-31 early in 4th before outscoring Spaulding 11-1 and took 37-36 lead with 4 minutes left ... Yogi Garcia had 13 points and George Cady 10 for Rutland, while Bill Mann 16 points and Marcey Rouleau 11 points for Spaulding.

1951 - Spaulding 50, Springfield 48

In a game featuring 13 lead changes and no lead of more than 4 points for either team, Spaulding rallied from a late 44-40 deficit to tie game at 46 and then hit 4 free throws to clinch win and take state title ... Al McLam led Spaulding with 12 points, while Marcey Rouleau and Harris Yett both had 10 ... Bob Salmond had 11 points for Springfield.

<u>1950 - Spaulding 48, MSJ 46</u>

Spaulding built a 12-point lead in the 3rd quarter and led 41-32 heading into the 4th quarter before holding off MSJ for the title ... MSJ free throw cut the deficit to 48-46 with 8 seconds left before missing a tying shot attempt at the buzzer ... **Bob Camire** had 14 points and **Bennt Trottier** 11 for Spaulding, while **Tom Lovett** game-high 16 points for MSJ.

1949 - Montpelier 50, Rutland 27

Rutland led 14-11 early in the 2nd quarter when Montpelier went on 10-1 run for a 21-15 halftime lead ... The Solons outscored the Raiders 12-4 in the 3rd to open up a 33-19 lead heading to the 4th quarter ... **Joe Kearney** hit 12 free throws in scoring 16 points to lead Montpelier, while **Johnn Bjorn** added 11 points ... **Bob Perkins** 7 points to lead Rutland.

1948 - Burlington 48, Bennington 28

BHS jumped out to 15-3 lead after 1st quarter and 21-3 early in 2nd before Bennington scored final 7 points of period ... Seahorses built lead to 33-13 after 3 and closest Bennington would cut deficit was 39-24 ... Joe Anger had 15 points to lead Burlington, while Jim Quinn added 11 points and Dick Fallon 10 ... Dan Scott led Bennington with 10 points.

1947 - Rutland 36, Bennington 34 (ot)

Carleton Laird's basket with 2 seconds left in 4th tied game 33-33, while **Johnny Ferraro's** jumper with 50 seconds left in overtime snapped 34-34 tie ... Tied 2-2 after 1, Raiders took 15-11 lead at half and 25-23 after 3 ... **Joe Davine** had game-high 18 points for Rutland, while Laird and Ferraro both 9 points ... **Dan Scott** had 11 points to lead Bennington.

<u> 1946 - Springfield 41, Montpelier 29</u>

Trailing 14-12 after the 1st quarter, Springfield outscored the Solons 6-0 in the 2nd for an 18-14 halftime lead before a 13-7 edge in 3rd quarter gave Cosmos 31-21 advantage heading to final period ... **Percy Clark** scored 11 of his game-high 13 points in 2nd half for Springfield, while **Kermit Morrison** added 12 points ... **John Garback** 10 points for Montpelier.

<u>1945 - Spaulding 34, MSJ 22</u>

After MSJ began the 4th quarter with a field goal cutting its deficit to 2 points, Spaulding scored the next 11 points to open up a 32-19 lead to claim the state title ... Spaulding had used a 10-3 run in 2nd quarter for a 17-12 halftime lead ... **Hilarie Sierra** had 9 points to lead Spaulding, while **Bob Fraser** had 8 points ... **Warnie Bolin** had 8 points for MSJ.

1944 - Montpelier 36, MSJ 25

After no tournaments in 1942 and 1943 due to World War II restrictions, Montpelier built a 14-5 lead after the 1st quarter and 23-11 at halftime to earn its 1st state title since 1935 ... The 2 teams combined for just 9 points during 3rd period ... **Gabby Garbach** had 10 points and **Frank Falacci** added 6 for Montpelier, while **Babe Spoon** scored 9 points for MSJ.

<u> 1941 - Burlington 31, Cathedral 28</u>

Pat Huntington had game-high 16 points for BHS, including 5 of Burlington's 7 points in the final 2 1/2 minutes as Seahorses rallied from 25-24 deficit ... Cathedral led 13-8 after 1st quarter, 19-16 at half and 23-22 after 3 periods ... **Billy Simpson** added 9 points for Burlington, while **Pal Evelti** 12 points and **Ken Brown** 11 points for Cathedral.

1940 - Cathedral 42, Burlington 37

Bob Merola scored game-high 18 points as Cathedral won its 2nd straight state title ... BHS led 16-11 in 2nd quarter before 11-4 Indians run for 22-20 Cathedral lead at half ... Cathedral led 33-26 after 3 quarters before BHS cut deficit to 39-37 with 1 minute left ... **Pal Evelti** added 8 points for Rice, while **Bob Twitchell** had 10 points for Burlington.

1939 - Cathedral 43, Burlington 22

Cathedral won its 1st state title since 1922 as **Bob Merola** scored a game-high 19 points ... Cathedral led 14-7 after 1st quarter, 22-16 at halftime and 31-21 after 3rd period before outscoring Burlington 12-1 in the 4th for the 21-point win ... **Henry Stannard** added 9 points and **Bob Lynch** 8 points for Cathedral, while **Bud O'Brien** had 9 points for Burlington.

1938 - Spaulding 37, Cathedral 35

Spaulding built a 12-3 lead after 1st quarter, led 19-14 at half and 34-25 after 3 periods before Cathedral rally cut deficit to 36-34 with 2 minutes left ... Gordon McKernan had 15 points to lead Spaulding, while Robert Ennis and Evertt Houston both had 9 ... Mike Quinn led Cathedral with 10 points, while Bob Merola and Phil Albarelli 9 points each.

1937 - Burlington 49, Proctor 21

Burlington won its 2nd straight state title with the 28-point victory over Proctor ... BHS led 11-6 after 1 period, 26-14 at half and 37-19 after 3 before outscoring Phantoms 12-2 in 4th ... Louis Marchacos had 14 points to lead Burlington, while Harold Deneault added 13 points and Billy Moulton 10 points ... Peanuts Kynoski had 6 points to lead Proctor.

1936 - Burlington 29, Bennington 19

Burlington used 16-3 edge in 3rd quarter to open up a 28-11 lead and held on for the 10-point victory ... The game was tied 7-7 after 1st period before BHS opened up 12-8 lead at half ... Bennington cut into 17-point 3rd quarter deficit by outscoring BHS 8-1 in 4th ... Louis Marchacos 12 points for BHS and Anthony DeVito had 7 points for Bennington.

1935 - Montpelier 34, Bennington 20

Angelo Lavin scored 13 of his game-high 19 points in 2nd half as Montpelier outscored Bennington 21-6 after trailing 14-13 at halftime ... Montpelier used a 10-1 edge in the 3rd quarter for a 23-15 lead and then outscored Bennington 11-5 in the 4th ... **Phil Ranslow** added 6 points for Montpelier, while **Llewelyn Daigneault** had 10 points for Bennington.

<u>1934 - Spaulding 34, Proctor 30</u>

Spaulding used a 15-5 edge in 2nd quarter for 19-9 halftime lead and held off late Proctor rally for the 4-point win ... Crimson led 23-9 early in 3rd when Proctor cut deficit to 26-19 heading to 4th ... John Angwin led Spaulding with 11 points, while **Rupert George** added 8 and Jesse Watson 7 ... **Ray Olson** 13 points and Mike Illinaki 10 for Proctor.

<u>1933 - Rutland 33, Hartford 26</u>

After trailing by 6 points at half, Rutland outscored Hartford 20-6 during the final 16 minutes to win 1st state title since 1928 ... Hartford led 19-13 at halftime before Rutland used 12-1 edge in 3rd period for 25-20 lead ... George Chalmers led Rutland with 10 points, while James Edler added 8 points ... Alphonso Regione led Hartford with 8 points.

<u>1932 - Spaulding 14, Proctor 13</u>

Proctor jumped out to a 7-0 advantage, led 9-6 at half and 12-9 after 3 quarters before a **John McGoff** field goal with 5 and 1/2 minutes left in the 4th gave Spaulding a 14-12 lead as neither team scored final 5 minutes in lowest scoring title game ... **John McKernan** had 6 points to lead Spaulding, while **Jack Shand** had 7 points and **Ed Baccei** 6 for Proctor.

1931 - Burlington 23, Cathedral 22

Whitey Palmer's basket with 15 seconds left gave BHS a 23-22 lead and their 2nd straight state title ... Cathedral took 14-4 lead at half, outscoring Burlington 8-0 in the 2nd quarter, and led 20-16 early in the 4th period before BHS ended game on a 7-2 run ... Ronny MacIntyre had 8 points for Burlington ... Bunny Brown had 6 points to lead Cathedral.

1930 - Burlington 25, Rutland 20

Burlington led 14-13 late in the 3rd when they scored final 2 points of the quarter and then started 4th period with a 7-1 run to open up a 23-14 lead over Rutland, which had won a 4 overtime semfinal game earlier in the day ... Marchacos had 11 points to lead BHS, while MacIntyre and Palmer had 5 points each ... Bove had 6 points to lead Rutland.

1929 - Hartford 32, Springfield 31

Johnson had a game-high 18 points, including the go ahead put-back field goal with 1:35 left in the game for the 32-31 Hartford lead ... Springfield led 17-14 at halftime and 28-20 after 3 quarters, but Johnson scored 6 of Hartford's 12 points in the 4th ... Falzaroni added 8 points for Hartford, while Hopkins had 12 points and Lovell 10 for Springfield.

1928 - Rutland 20, Cathedral 15

Cathedral led 9-3 after the 1st quarter and 12-5 early in the 2nd period, but Cathedral did not have a field goal over the final 21 minutes of the game ... Rutland built a 15-14 lead after 3 quarters and went on to win its 1st-ever state title ... **Layden** had 7 points to lead Rutland, while **Crowley** added 6 and Keefe 5 ... **Dunn** a game-high 9 points for Cathedral.

1927 - Burlington 25, Springfield 15

Burlington won its 3rd state title in 6 years as BHS jumped out to a 6-0 lead and slowly increased the advantage, leading 8-3 after 1 quarter and 12-6 at half ... Closest Springfield could get in 2nd half was 17-12 late in 3rd quarter ... **Warner** had a game-high 12 points for Burlington, while **Preston** added 7 points ... **C Tarro** 7 points for Springfield.

1926 - Montpelier 41, Spaulding 17

After leading by just 5 points at half, Montpelier outscored Spaulding 29-10 in the 2nd half to win 2nd straight state title ... Montpelier led 12-7 at halftime before using a 16-3 edge in 3rd for a 28-10 lead and 13-7 edge in 4th ... Sheridan had a game-high 17 points for Montpelier, while **H Donnelly** added 8 points ... **Papazoni** had 4 points to lead Spaulding.

1925 - Montpelier 22, Rutland 19

Montpelier jumped out to a 7-0 lead before Rutland cut the deficit to 7-5 at the end of the 1st period ... Montpelier led throughout the contest, leading 13-12 at halftime and 18-15 after 3 quarters before holding on for 3-point victory ... **Donnelly** had 10 points and **Sheridan** 8 for Montpelier, while **Bellarose** 8 points and **Hagan** 6 points for Rutland.

1924 - Burlington 30, Montpelier 23

Burlington won its 2nd straight state title as BHS led 8-5 after the 1st period and increased the advantage to 14-7 in the 2nd before Montpelier cut deficit to 15-14 at half ... BHS built lead back to 8 at 26-18 after scoring the first 3 points of the 4th quarter ... **Slocum** had a game-high 11 points for Burlington, while **Sheridan** scored 9 points for Montpelier.

1923 - Burlington 35, Cathedral 21

Burlington won its 1st-ever state title with the victory over defending champion Cathedral ... Burlington dominated the 1st half, leading 24-6 at the break ... Cathedral was able to cut the deficit to 29-16 after 3 quarters ... **Prentice** had 12 points to lead BHS, while **Price** added 7 points ... **Stannard** had 11 points for Cathedral, while **Gervais** added 6 points.

1922 - Cathedral 28, Hardwick 24

Cathedral won the 1st-ever state title by snapping a 10-10 tie with final 6 points and first 2 points of 2nd half for an 8-point lead ... Hardwick cut the deficit to 4 before Cathedral 3 straight points for 28-21 lead ... **Boiselle** had 14 points to lead Cathedral, while **Polworth** 8 points and **McGauhan** 6 ... **Young** game-high 15 points and **Thomas** 9 for Hardwick
